

AIR-CONDITIONING MARKET STATISTICS- MACHINES JANUARY-DECEMBER 2010

AFEC has held its annual meeting on Chillers and Air-Conditioning sales statistics, corresponding to 2010.

Criteria for assessment are based on manufacturers' sales prices, and in the case of split type equipment, the number of equipment units correspond to outdoor units. In all cases the figures refer to units invoiced by manufactures.

Sales figures per sector include the following units:

- **Residential /Domestic**
 - Portable and window type.
 - Split type equipment, single and multi, below 6 kW.
 - Low profile ducted equipment.

- **Commercial Sector**
 - Split type equipment, single and multi, over 6 kW.
 - Cassettes.
 - Package units, except low profile units, and rooftops.
 - VRF units up to 32 kW.
 - Chillers up to 50 kW,

- **Tertiary/Industrial Sector**
 - Chillers from 50 kW and up and fan coils.
 - VRF units over 32 kW.

The market measured amounts to: 850,91 Million Euros.

- **Residential/Domestic Equipment**

Figures corresponding to 2010, according to data provided by participating companies are: **405,61 Million Euros.**

- **Commercial Market**

Turnover, according to data provided by manufacturers of these equipment, amounts to: **278,60 Million Euros.**

- **Tertiary/Industrial Market**

Turnover in this segment amounts to **166,70 Million Euros.**

- **Total market**

Total 2010 annual sales are: **850,91 Million Euros**, which represents a decrease of 4,42 % in respect to the preceding year, 2009.
